## 1 SmogShoppe

This former smog-check center in Culver City has been transformed into an urban garden oasis—and a 100-percent solar-powered one at that! ## 2 Viceroy Santa Monica

## 10 Rancho Las Lomas

After the vows, move to The Grand Salon, an indoor space with French doors leading out to patios and a gorgeous stone fountain.
